PE- Premium Action Plan 2016/2017

Funding Allocation-£8876 + £4090 carried over from previous year

In 2013 the Government introduced a PE and Sport Premium grant for primary schools. It was designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offered their pupils.

For 2016/17, Foxdell Infants received £8876 and had a balance of £4090 carried over from the previous year, giving a total of £12966. Details of how this was spent and the impact it had on PE and sport across the school are shown below.
