Understanding the World



As the weather changes, we will explore how seasons change and link this to learning about light and dark. We will find about nocturnal animals and what helps them to manage in the dark. Outside, we will plant and care for a bulb. Linking to our Expressive Arts and Design, we will find out how people celebrate Hanukkah and Christmas.

Physical Development



During PE lessons, we will develop our footwork by learning a one leg balance and learning how to jump and land safely. We will also learn a seated balance. There will be daily opportunities for us to practise our fine motor skills to support our later writing skills. On our 'Funky Fingers' table we will develop threading, pinching and pouring skills.

Maths



Our Maths learning will tocus on recognising and talking about 2D shapes using vocabulary such as sides, cornes, straight and curved. We will go on shape hunts in the environment and compare shapes, looking for similarities and differences. In our number work, we will look at the composition of 4 and 5. We will introduce what an odd and even number is, and learn how to find 1 more and 1 less. Using objects we will share equally between groups and find ways to problem solve. We will also look at time and compare

night and day.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As the term progresses, we will continue to explore how we learn using 'The Foxdell Way.' We will identify something we are good at and learn that everyone is good at different things. We will learn how to be a kind friend and which words to use to express our own needs and feelings. We will also practise how to give compliments.
