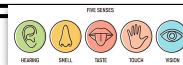
Music



We will be moving to the pulse and learning to sing songs in unison. We will learn the names of some tuned and percussion instruments and learn to play some percussion instruments with control.

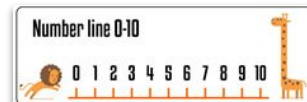
Science
