English

Key texts: Jim and the Beanstalk

This term, we will be reading a fiction book about Jim and the Beanstalk. Jim climbs up the beanstalk and is transported to a world of the Giant. We will use this story to create a portal story when our character will transport to another world.

History

We will be looking at similarities and differences between life of two famous monarchs; Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria. In addition, we will discuss the role of the monarchs and parliament in the UK. Later, we will look at

our local area-Luton and how it has changed over time.

ART
This term the children will be learning how to shape and decorate clay, create a pinch pot, design and make clay tile with house features. They will develop practical skills working with clay and apply their artistic skills in a structured project.

RE

We will be learning about inspiring individuals from different religions. We will read stories which inspire Christians, Muslims and Jewish people.

Music

In music we will continue to learn about rhythm, tempo and dynamics. We will learn new songs and explore our voice as an instrument.

Science

Our half term will start with looking at planting and growing. We will plant a bean seed and closely observe how it changes overtime. We will learn about seed dispersion and how that helps plants to spread and survive.

Maths

In maths, the children will be learning about shapes including fractions. Children will learn how to to recognise, half, third and quarter of a shape. We will be also looking at fractions of numbers. After, we will learn how to read the time including o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Children will be using both, analogue and digital clocks.

PE

During PE lessons the children will be learning how to control the ball and create different moves to the music. They will create their own games and activities and decide on the set of rules.

PSHE

Our topic is called 'Relationships', where we look at how we feel being a part of a family and what relationships we form within it. We will discuss conflict with friends as part of the topic and main focus will be on how to solve it.

Computing

We will be looking at computer algorithms and how to program a robot to move and make other choices. We will also look at how to behave online in ways that do not upset others and to look at different examples.
