Maths

In maths, we will start by learning about position and

direction. We will then look at reading scales using temperature and looking at lines of symmetry in shapes. We will then revisit previous learning such as place value and using tens and ones, counting using money and adding and subtracting using the column method.

PE

During PE lessons the children will be developing their skills of working in teams to throw and catch, jump and race in preparation for sports day.

Geography

We will be looking at maps from around our local area. We will also be creating our own maps of parts of the school, labelling them and making a key. We will also be looking at maps from around the world.

DT

This half term the children will learn how to make a moving monster. They will be taught how to use pivots, levers and linkage. They will be using these to put together their moving monster so it can move.

Music

In music we will continue to learn about rhythm, tempo and dynamics. We will learn new songs and explore our voice as an instrument.

PSHE

Our topic is called 'Changing Me', where we look at how we changed from a baby to now. We will discuss life cycles and how people change when they get older.

We will be learning about 'What is the Good News that Jesus brings?' We will be thinking about what good news means generally and look at how stories inspire Christians to show love, forgiveness and peace.

Science

This half-term, we will revisit the topic of 'animals' and look at animal groups such as fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including humans. We will recap our learning about animals and their offspring.

Computing

We will learn the functions of the 2Paint a Picture tool. • and use it learn recreate the Impressionist style of art (Monet, Degas, Renoir). We will also look at artist such as Seurat, Piet Mondrian and William Morris.
