English Our focus text for this half term is 'The Journey Home'. We will write a story based on this text focusing on using story and sentence openings and endings that engage the reader and describing the characters. For example, we might use openings such as 'later that day' or 'early one bright day', and endings like 'just in the nick of time' or 'in the end.'

History This half term, we will explore the development of transport and travel throughout history. We will look at chronology through timelines and making comparisons between old and new forms of transport.

Art/DT We will explore the formal elements of art such as pattern, texture and tone. Children will create printed patterns using everyday objects, take rubbings using different media and learn how to make their drawings three dimensional.

RE We will explore beliefs about offerings to show gratitude. We will analyse a range of sources including survey data, discover the artefacts used during Hindu puja and write lyrics for a song of thanks.
