Key text: Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo

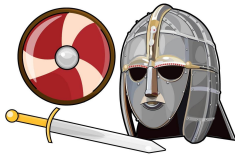
During English lessons this half term, we will look at adventure stories and identify the features so we can write our own adventure stories.



History

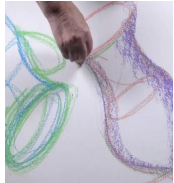
This half term, the children will learn about the Anglo Saxons. We will learn about who the Anglo Saxons were and what their settlements looked like.

Beech Class have swimming lessons every Wednesday- please remember your swimming kits.

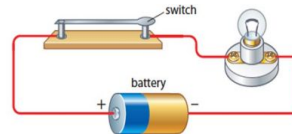
Homework will be given out on a Wednesday and is due the following Monday.

Music

This half term the children will focus on electricity. We will learn about insulators and conductors.



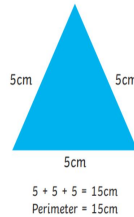
French

Maths

Our maths this half term focuses on multiplication and division as well as length and perimeter. We will continue with the Mastering Numbers

Programme which enables children to develop fluency in multiplication and division facts. Remember to do some Times Tables Rock Stars - we recommend at least three times each week, but every day is even better!



PE The children will be learning about balance and how to use different parts of their bodies to balance. We will also be focusing on dance. PE lessons will take place as follows: **Ash**— Tuesday and Friday; **Beech** — Tuesday and Wednesday (swimming); **Oak** — Tuesday and Friday.

PSHE

The children will explore their dreams and goals. We will learn about creating and achieving goals as well as overcoming obstacles of disappointment.
