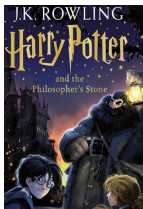


English

Key Text: Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone by J.K. Rowling

During English lessons this half term, we will look at explanation texts and identify the key features. This includes: causal conjunctions, adverbials and rhetorical questions.



Geography

This half term, pupils will be learning about rivers and will identify and describe the physical features of rivers. Pupils will also explore why rivers are important, understanding their role in supporting habitats, wildlife, and human life.



Computing

In computing, we will learn about data logging using micro bits. As part of this unit, we will be analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information.

RE In RE, the children will explore, where the language of scripture matters. They will look at religious stories and how teachings were originally passed down through oral tradition before being written down.

Music
